

Continuation page attached to the SEARCH WARRANT application, dated Friday, September 13, 2019 of September 17th through September 21st 2018, I participated and completed Basic Crime Scene Academy School were I obtained a certificate.

On 09/12/2019, Sarah Lee called 911 due to her son, Brandon Embry, not responding to phone calls or answering the door of his apartment for two days. Mr. Embry lost his job two days ago and was not heard from again. Officer Kivett was let in the apartment by maintenance and located Mr. Embry naked on the bedroom floor. Mr. Embry had numerous wounds to include face and head wounds. There was bloodstains in the apartment in several areas and also overturned furniture. Mr. Embry also had wounds around both wrists and appeared to be consistent with marks from handcuffs, of which a pair were found in the apartment on a small stand. Mr. Embry was rushed to Randolph Health and was unresponsive. It is unknown if Mr. Embry lives alone or not.

On 09/12/2019 at 1725 hours, I was able to obtain a search warrant on the apartment that Detective Snodgrass obtained. While, I was conducting a search of the residence and gathering evidence. I was unable to locate the victim's wallet and keys inside the apartment. I was also, unable to locate the victim's keys to his Silver 2016 Chevrolet Silverado displaying North Carolina Registration Number Plate of FKW-7075, which is parked outside his apartment door with the truck doors unlocked one parking space to the south.

I respectfully request the Courts to issue a search warrant for the vehicle located at 711 South Church Street Apartment A and the Silver 2016 Chevrolet Silverado Displaying North Carolina Registration Number Plate of FKW-7075. This search warrant would assist the Asheboro Police Department in the investigation of Mr. Embry's apparent assault.
